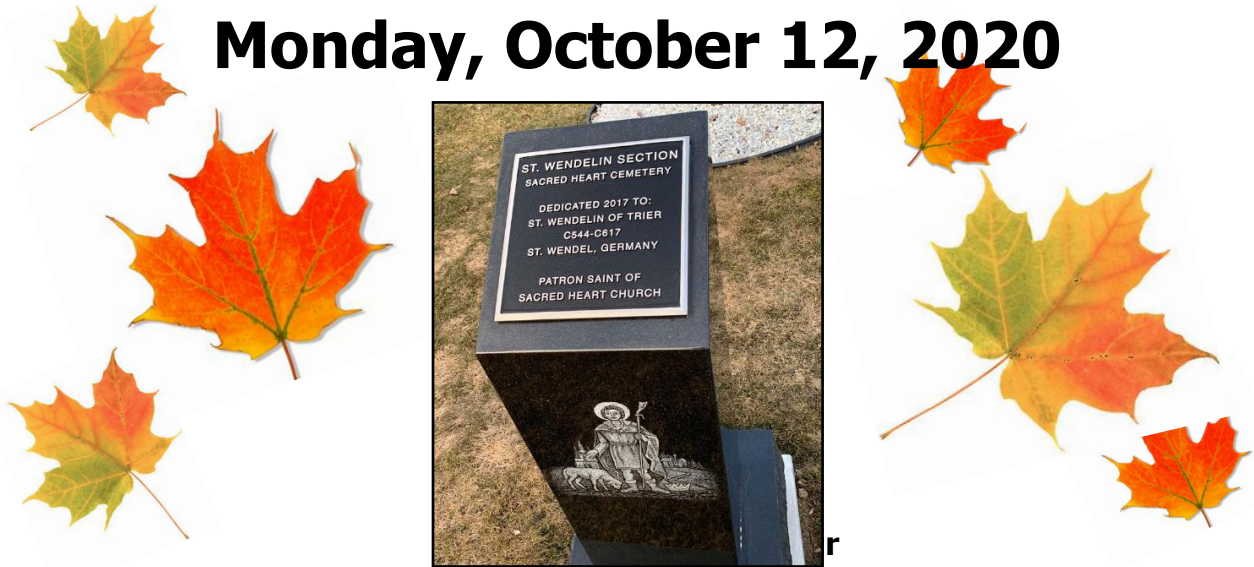


The Steuben County Historical Society
